

Name of Position: Part-time/Project-based Counselling Psychologist

Core duties and responsibilities include:

- Provide counselling (in groups and individually) for children, adolescents and adults;
- Conduct clients using psychological assessments and tools;
- Interpret test data;
- Conduct inquiry into available psychometric tools to meet the individual needs of clients;
- Deliver outreach psycho-educational service to NGOs, schools and other agencies;
- Maintain records of client and client groups;
- Write psychological reports and Individual Education Plan (IEP);
- Conduct research including proposal writing, literature review, data collection, analysis and report writing etc. and
- Perform other duties as assigned.

The ideal candidate should be an outgoing, passionate, dynamic, and organized team player who is also able to work well individually. He/She must possess:

- A Master's degree in Counselling Psychology;
- Member of Hong Kong Psychological Society or other recognised professional bodies;
- Clinical experience in the field of counselling with research experience preferably in counselling and psychology (recent graduates with recognized outstanding work experience in the field of counselling will also be considered);
- Knowledge of psychotherapy and psychological assessment tools;
- Excellent organizational and time-management skills and the ability to coordinate multiple and complex projects while maintaining high standards and accuracy;
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills;
- Proficiency in SPSS, NVIVO or ETC
- Excellent spoken and written English and Chinese (Cantonese);
- Confidence in public speaking and ability to communicate information in an accessible way;
- Proficiency in Chinese and English word-processing;
